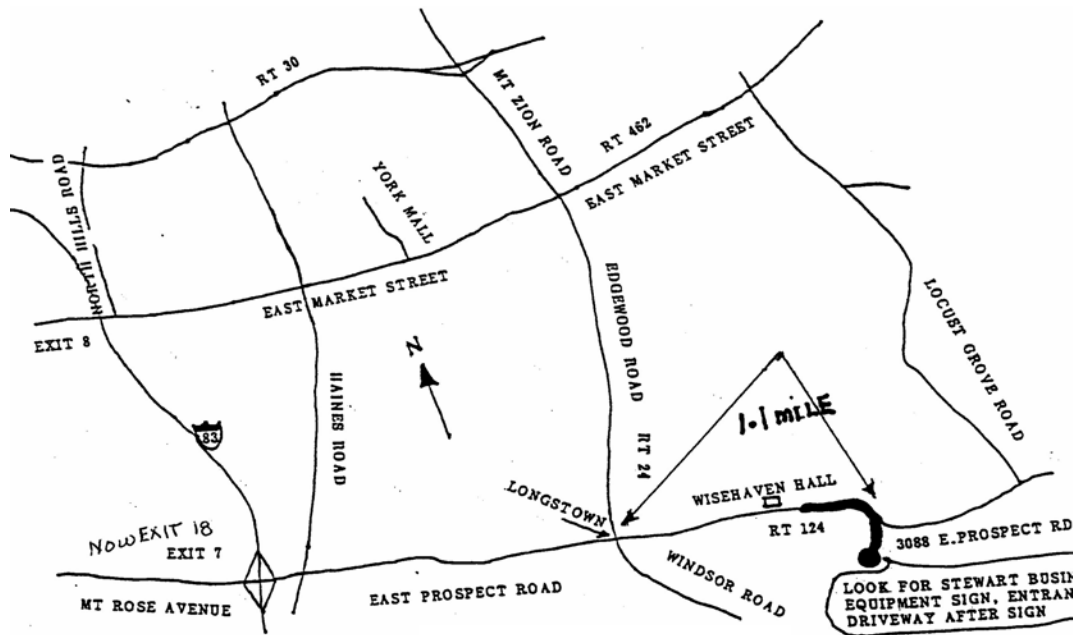
## WOODWORKING SHOW
