WEED POT Demo by Mike Galloway





Mike did an excellent demo on making a weed pot. No, this is not "weed" or pot" that is used for recreational purposes. It could take a lot of variations. The turning of it is relatively easy, but the glue up is tricky, says Mike. Inner block must be square and outer pieces must overlap. Piece can be held between centers with no chuck required. Make blank about 6 3/4" x 1" sq.

Demo – Elmer Absher –Turning a Table Leg using Reverse Turning
